



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
Rhyming Time

Directions: Help Jake finish his homework with words that rhyme with his name! Come up with five words and then draw a picture of that word in the box next to it.




Cleaning Up

Responsibility



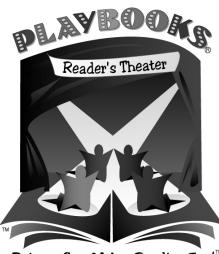
